

PROGRAM OVERVIEW- GAP




- Focuses on identifying viable business opportunities linked to agroecology clusters and value chains, providing investment support for integrated agroecology production systems
- Offer grants to MSEs and agroecology Producer Organization Enterprises (POEs) to improve their value addition and market linkages
- Minimum 30% of the project cost as co-finance in terms of their contribution/ loan/equity of the enterprise
- Grant support to impact vulnerable social groups, small producers, women, youth, and other disadvantaged groups
- Grant Support ranging from Rs. 2 million to Rs. 20 million

GRANT FOR AGROECOLOGICAL PROGRAMS (GAP)

Objective of the program- To improve the businesses, enhance their agroecological outcomes, and provide tangible benefits to small producers in the value chain

Three aspects that distinguish GAP from traditional value chain investment programs are:



TYPES OF GAP FUND



Regular Fund

Rs. 2 million to up to Rs.10 million

Open for 10 focus states and to remain open throughout the year.

Challenge Fund


Grant above Rs. 10 million and up to Rs. 20 million

10 AGROECOLOGICAL PRINCIPLES



- <u>Diversity</u>: key to ensuring food security and nutrition while conserving, protecting, and enhancing natural resources.
- <u>Synergies</u>: building synergies enhances key functions across food systems, supporting production and multiple ecosystem services.
- **Efficiency:** innovative agroecological practices produce more using less external resources.
- **<u>Recycling</u>**: more recycling means agricultural production with lower economic and environmental costs.
- <u>Co-creation and sharing knowledge</u>: agri. innovations respond better to local challenges when cocreating through participatory processes.





- <u>Resilience</u>: enhanced resilience of people, communities, and ecosystems key to sustainable food and agricultural systems.
- <u>Human and Social Values</u>: protecting and improving rural livelihoods, equity, and social well-being for sustainable food and agricultural systems.
- <u>Culture and Food Traditions</u>: supporting healthy, diversified, and culturally appropriate diets, agroecology contributes to food security and nutrition while maintaining the health of ecosystems.
- <u>Responsible Governance</u>: sustainable food and agriculture require responsible and effective governance mechanisms at different scales from local to national to global
- <u>Circular and Solidarity Economy</u>: reconnect producers and consumers and provides innovative solutions for living while ensuring the social foundation for inclusive and sustainable development
